Things to Note

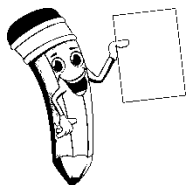
- ☺ **From 8 January**, I come to school in my P.E. attire on days I have PE and PAL lessons.
- ☺ Inform my teacher when I am not well.
- ☺ I must know where to go to after dismissal.
- ☺ If someone is picking me up, they will wait for me at the coloured school gate during dismissal time.
- ☺ My parents can call the General Office at **65832125** if they need to make any enquiries.
- ☺ When my parents come to school, they have to report to the Security Post to get a visitor's pass and proceed to General Office.

Dismissal Arrangement

There are 6 dismissal possibilities:

1. Exit from the red gate (nearest to block 768, just beside canteen area)
2. Exit from the orange gate (nearest to block 763, at ISH area)
3. Exit from the blue gate (nearest to security post)
4. School bus / private transport (school foyer)
5. After school care (Nascans)
6. After school care (private arrangement)
